

Mission

We seek to promote leadership through service, respect, and appreciation for the participants and beneficiaries alongside credit and distinction for our donors and supporters. Let the mission of Derby Days—serving the community—provide the foundation for each event and govern every action before, during, and following Derby Days.

Snap-A-Sig [Monday]

Date: Monday, April 6th

Time Frame: 7:30 am - 6:30 pm

Deadline: Must submit photo albums by 10 pm

Objective: You and your team must find and take as many pictures with active Bryant Sigma

Chi brothers

Rules:

1. All active brothers on campus should be wearing letters.

- a. Brothers without letters will not be counted.
- b. Do Not search for brothers off-campus
- c. Brothers who are sick or not on campus the entire day will not be counted towards any teams
- 2. There must be at least 2 girls from your team in each picture
 - a. Pictures with less than 2 girls in them will receive no credit
- 3. Every contestant must wear their Derby Days shirts
- 4. All constants must ask each brother you take a picture with "Why do you Derby?" Make sure to record the name, question, and answer for each brother to receive credit for that brother.
 - a. The brother will answer the question with a response of what Derby Days means to them.
- 5. All pictures must be submitted via Facebook in the form of an album to the Derby Days Facebook Page: Derby Days Sigma Chi Lambda Eta
 - a. Name your album: Derby Days Pictures!: "Team Name"
 - b. The question and answer for each brother should be written in the description of the appropriate picture.
 - i. If you do not include the question and answer for the pictured brother, you will receive no credit for that brother.
 - c. Have your teammates or Brother Captains tag all brothers in each picture.
- 6. The following areas are off-limits
 - a. The Derby Days Coin War tables in the Roto
 - i. Only brothers who are signed up working the tables are off-limits
 - ii. There are a maximum of 2 brothers signed up per table per hour
 - b. Any and all classrooms/labs in the Unistructure
 - c. A brother's actual room (where his bed is)
 - d. Bathrooms
 - e. The Interfaith Center
 - f. The Chace Wellness Center
- 7. Photoshopping brothers into pictures will not be counted

Derby Decoration [Tuesday]

Date: Tuesday, April 7th

Time: 8 am -4 pm (Voting is from 5 pm-10:00pm)

Location: Fisher Student Center Windows

Objective: To decorate the designated window area in the FSC while following these rules:

Rules

- 1. You and your team will be decorating your window space provided in the FSC
- 2. In your window space, you must incorporate the following:
 - a. Derby Days
 - b. Your Team
 - c. Sigma Chi
- 3. Each team will be given one (1) set of window markers
 - a. You may bring any other supplies that are removable
 - b. You cannot bring tape
 - i. You may use blue painters tape provided by the Information Desk at the FSC
 - c. Any damage to the FSC or any areas left unclean will result in a 500 deduction towards their grand total
- 4. You are only allowed to use the windows space you are provided in the FSC
- 5. No rough housing or going outside of designated area
- 6. No writing over or destroying another team's space
- 7. You cannot start prior to 10 am nor can you work after 4 pm

Voting

- 1. The general public will be voting on the best windows by picking up a voting sheet at the Derby Days table by the FSC fireplace
 - a. Coin wars tabling will also occur during the voting time period
- 2. Polls open at 5 pm and close at 10:00 pm
- 3. Anyone can vote
 - a. An individual cannot vote more than once
 - b. You cannot vote upon someone's behalf
- 4. This events placement will be determined by total number of votes.

The Triple Crown (Field Events) [Wednesday]

Date: Wednesday, April 8th

Time: 3 pm – 5 pm

Location: FSC Lawn (Rain location: MAC)

Objective: *Teams complete in 3 rounds of field events for 1st place!*

Rounds & Rules

Round 1 – Limbo Contest (Participants Only)

1. One (1) member per team will be participating

- 2. A pole is held parallel to the ground by two people
- 3. Contestants will form a line and in turn, attempt to pass under the bar.
- 4. After everyone has made an attempt. The bar will be lowered and the process will repeat.
- 5. You must bend backwards. No part of your body may touch the bar and no part other than your feet may touch the ground
- 6. Last contestant standing wins!
- 7. If a winner cannot be determined, the final two will receive points equal to the average of the 1st place and 2nd place points.

Round 2 – Arm Wrestling Tournament (Captains Only)

- 1. One (1) captain per team will be participating
- 2. Tournament seeding is determined by your previous days' point totals
- 3. Contestants may only use one hand
- 4. Contestants may not use their other hand at any point. Doing so will result in disqualification
- 5. Constants must keep their elbow on the table at all times. Failing to do so will result in disqualification
- 6. To start each match, both players will clasps hands in the middle
- 7. To win, you must push the other contestant's hand to the table.
- 8. If at any point, the hand you're competing touches the table, the other contestant wins.
 - a. A consolation match will be used to determine 3rd and 4th place

Round 3 – Hut, Hut, Hike! (Participants + Captains)

- 1. Each team will be represented by 1 participant and 1 of their team captains.
- 2. The two will work together
- 3. One player will throw (hike) toilet paper through their legs (like a football center) and attempt to get the toilet paper through a hoop 15 feet away
 - a. This player must stay in the same spot, 15 feet away from the hoop
- 4. The other player will retrieve the toilet paper back to your partner
- 5. Placement for this round will be determined by the most number of toilet paper through the hoop in 1 minute.
- 6. If a winner cannot be determined, the final two will receive points equal to the average of the 1st place and 2nd place points.

Sign-A-Sig/The 99 Fundraiser [Thursday]

Sign-A-Sig

Date: Thursday, April 9th **Time Frame:** 7:30 am – 5 pm

Objective: You and your team must find and sign ("tag") as many Sigma Chi brothers as

possible. Tags should be your team name or logo.

Rules

- 1. All active Sigma Chi brothers on campus should be wearing white t-shirts. Do not tag a brother's non-white shirt
 - a. Do not search for brothers off-campus
 - b. Brothers who are sick or not on campus the entire day will not be counted towards any teams
- 2. The following areas are off-limits
 - a. The Derby Days Coin War tables in the roto
 - i. Only brothers who are signed up working the tables are off-limits
 - ii. There are a maximum of 3 brothers signed up per table per hour
 - b. Any and all classrooms/labs in the Unistructure
 - c. A brother's actual room (where his bed is)
 - d. Bathrooms
 - e. The Interfaith Center
 - f. The Chace Wellness Center
- 3. Brothers are not allowed to run indoors but may evade teams outdoors
- 4. Standings for this event are determined by most number tagged brothers

The 99 Restaurant Fundraiser

Date: Thursday, April 9th **Time Frame:** 12 pm – 12 am

Objective: To relax from your work thus far and enjoy a nice meal at our local 99

Rules:

- 1. Each team will receive 400 points for attending and will receive 50 points per team member and captain that goes.
 - a. Non-participating friends may also attend this event with you. You will receive 100 points per person that comes to support you.
- 2. 10% of your check will be added to your online donation total and receive points as an online donation (\$1 = 25 points)
 - a. The check of your friends that come to the event as well will also be counted for your team
- 3. You must send a picture of your team and your supporting friends as well as your team's and your friend's receipt to the derbydaysbryant@gmail.com in order to receive points. Please put "99 Fundraiser YOUR TEAM NAME" in the subject
- 4. **Thursday night at The 99 is trivia night and 49 cent wings!** Although trivia does not count towards Derby Days points, please enjoy the food and free trivia (trivia starts at 7:30 pm). Plus, The 99 is awarding the winner of trivia night Red Sox tickets!

Derby Pageant [Saturday]

Date: Saturday, April 11th **Time:** 4:45 pm – 7:00 pm **Location:** Papitto/Heritage

Objective: You and your team will be competing in a 3 round pageant contest!

Description & Rules:

Round 1+2: Fashion Show

- 1. Round 1 Derby Attire (Female Participants Only)
 - a. Female participants will be wearing their best Derby outfit for the runway!
 - b. Select 1 member to represent your team
- 2. Round 2 Formal Wear (Team Captains Only)
 - a. Team captains will be wearing their best formal outfit the runway!
 - b. Select 1 team captain to represent your team
 - c. Your team will be dressing your selected team captain in women's formal clothing; meaning, your captain will be cross-dressing.
- 3. Judges will score these 2 rounds based on the following criteria:
 - a. Overall Appearance
 - b. Creativity of outfit
 - c. Walk
 - d. Confidence
 - e. Audience Response
- 4. You will have 5 minutes in between the end of round 1 and the beginning round 2 to. When the 5 minutes are up, you must clear the changing area.
- 5. Due to limited space, you may have up to 3 team members helping your selected participants and captain with the outfit at a time.
- 6. All outfits must be appropriate
 - a. Any inappropriate or provocative clothing can result in a 500 point deduction from your total.

Round 3: Talent Show

- 1. The last round is an open format talent show and is open to the entire team and team captains. The judges will score this last round based on the following criteria:
 - a. Overall Performance
 - b. Creativity
 - c. Connection to Derby Days
 - d. Number of team members/captains
 - e. Audience Response
- 2. Each act may only run 5 minutes maximum
 - a. Penalties will be given to the teams that go overtime
 - b. There is no minimum time limit
 - c. If you are using music at any point, please submit all music by **1 pm the day of the event or earlier**
 - i. Please keep all language in all music appropriate (Mom friendly)
- 3. Any team found cheating/breaking the rules in any way will be disqualified from this event and receive -500 point penalty toward their grand total

Points

- 1. Rounds 1+2 are worth 50% and Round 3 is worth 50% of this event's points.
- 2. Standings for this event are determined by the team with the most combined points after 3 rounds.

Derby Pageant (Cont.) [Saturday]

Participation/Spectator Bonus

- 1. You will receive 100 points for every team member and captain that attends the event
- 2. You will receive 50 points for every spectator that attends the event to support your team
 - a. Your team's spectators must check in with CJ Dona
 - b. Admission for all spectators are free!

Raffle Giveaways

- 1. We will be having over \$1,000 worth of raffle items
 - a. 1 ticket = \$3
 - b. 2 tickets = \$5
 - c. Arm's length worth of tickets = \$20
- 2. You can pay for tickets via cash, check, or credit/debit card
- 3. Any team member who participates in the raffle will receive 50 points for every dollar spent on raffle tickets
- 4. Any spectator who attends the event to support your team and purchases raffle tickets, will receive 100 points for every dollar spent on raffle tickets.
 - a. When your spectator purchases raffle tickets, he or she will sign a sheet and write your team name down to keep track of points.

On-Going Events [Everyday] - Coin Wars

Time Frame (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday): Daily 10:00 am - 3:00 pm

*Time Frame for Tuesday: 5 pm - 10 pm (same time as Derby Decoration Voting)

Locations: Roto – Media Wall near Salmo (Blue League) & Under the Clocks (Gold League)

*Location for Tuesday: FSC Fireplace (Both Blue and Gold Leagues)

Objective: Teams compete to collect the most coins in their respective coin jar

Rules:

- 1. Each team must decorate and personalize their coin jar
- 2. Teams that return their decorated coin jar by 10 am on Monday April 6th will automatically receive 100 bonus points towards their grand total
 - a. All coin jars must be placed at the Derby Days table by 12pm (noon) Wednesday, April $8^{\rm h}$
- 3. The objective of Coin War is to collect as many coins as possible each day in your coin jar
 - a. All coins must valid U.S. currency or they will be disregarded
 - b. There are no restrictions on value of each individual on the value of each coin
 - c. There is no limit on the number of coins you can put in your jar
 - d. Jars cannot be removed from the Derby Days table for any reason
- 4. Putting bills into another team's coin jar will count against the coins in their jar
 - a. Example: If a coin jar has 100 pennies in it, and a \$1 is placed in the jar, you will negate the 100 pennies.
 - b. There is no limit to the amount of bills you can put in other team's jar.
- 5. The water jugs are emptied and counted each day
- 6. Points are allocated for Coin Wars each weekday according to total value of coins minus total value of dollar bills in each coin jar.
 - a. 100 point bonus for each daily 1st place finish in coin wars

On-Going Events [Everyday] - Online Donations

Time Frame: Daily 8:01 pm - 7:59 pm

Location: Your Derby Days online team page!

Objective: Teams compete to collect the most donations on their online team page!

Rules:

- 1. Each Derby Day team will have their own online donations page.
- 2. Teams can have any person or party contribute to the online donations page.
- 3. The point conversion for online donations is \$1 = 1 point.
- 4. The donations will be calculated daily and bonus points will be allocated to each team based on overall daily performance.
 - a. 100 point bonus for each daily 1st place finish in online donations
- 5. The calculation of the online donations will be calculated at 8pm sharp on each day.
 - a. Any donations after 8pm will be calculated towards the next day's performance.
- 6. Each team member will receive 10 points per email sent to qualifying people (see below) about donating to their online donation page
 - a. Must BCC the Derby Daddy derbydaysbryant@gmail.com
 - b. Family, friends, facility, staff, and alumni all qualify
 - i. Emails sent to friends within Bryant will not be counted
 - ii. Emails sent to other participants will not be counted
 - iii. Emails sent to brothers at Bryant will not be counted
 - iv. Repeated emails will not be counted
- 7. The online donations platform will be open throughout Derby Days.
 - a. The online donations will start on Sunday, April 6th at 12:00 pm (noon)
 - b. The online donations will close on Saturday, April 12th at Midnight
 - c. All online donations must be submitted prior to the Saturday deadline to count towards the respective team's grand total.

- 1. 1 point for every retweet or favorite on the Bryant Sigma Chi account (@bryantsigmachi)
- 2. 1 point for every positive tweet about Derby Days using the #BryantDerbyDays (limit of 5 per team member, per day)

Instagram

1. 3 points for every Instagram picture posted. Must use the #BryantDerbyDays (limit of 5 per team, member per day)

On-Going Events [Specified Days] – Participations/Spectator Bonus

- 1. Your team will receive points per team member and captain who attends the following events
 - a. Wednesday: Field Events (50 points per team member and captain)
 - b. Thursday: The 99 Restaurant Fundraiser (50 points per team member and captain)
 - c. Saturday: Derby Pageant (100 points per team member and captain)
- 2. Your team will receive points per spectator that comes to support you during the following events
 - a. Wednesday: Field Events (25 points per spectator)
 - b. Saturday: Derby Pageant (50 points per spectator)
 - i. For these days, please have your spectators check in with CJ Dona to receive the points
